Anne Hickman-Hudgins Named Director of Landscape for Horseshoe Bay Resort

Hickman-Hudgins brings more than 15 years of experience in landscape design and botany as well as more than 14 years of experience in the club and resort industry. She is responsible for all landscaping at the Resort, including buildings, boulevards and parking lots as well as planning and executing all seasonal planting.

Since 1994 and prior to her arrival at Horseshoe Bay Resort, Hickman-Hudgins served as the environmental coordinator and grounds manager for Barton Creek Resort & Spa where she developed and implemented annual grounds maintenance procedures and budget for 12 acres of resort grounds and 14 acres of residential grounds. Previously, she directed the maintenance of interior plants in professional environments as plantscape technician for Grahams Interiors in San Diego, California.

Hickman-Hudgins also lived in San Marcos, Texas while working as a botany lab instructor for freshman students at Texas State University from 1987 until 1993. While teaching, she simultaneously established ECOSPACE, a landscape maintenance and installation company in San Marcos in 1992.

During Hickman-Hudgins' extensive career, she has earned significant awards and recognition, including 2003 Audubon International recognition for the Fazio Canyons Golf Course at Barton Creek Resort & Spa as a Certified Audubon Signature Sanctuary. Her determination and dedication to the environment resulted in Fazio Canyons' recognition by Audubon International as "...the first certified resort golf course in Texas and the 46th certified Signature Sanctuary in the world." She also received the prestigious GCSAA National Environmental Steward Award in 1999 and 2001. While with ClubCorp, Hickman-Hudgins was also a national recipient of the Super Star Award in 2003 and, in the same year, was recognized with her team as a ClubCorp Team of Excellence.
