Legends Junior Tour and Horseshoe Bay Resort reach two-year agreement

DALLAS, Texas (October 22, 2009) - The Legends Junior Tour announced it has reached a two-year agreement with Horseshoe Bay Resort to host the Texas State Junior Championship. The 54-hole resort in Horseshoe Bay will host the Championship in 2010 and 2011.
